Basal Cell Carcinoma A Patient Recovers at Home

Lori Williams had an annoying irritation, actually a lesion, at the side of her right nostril for three or four years It didn't change much, until finally, at the age of 43, Lori found that the lesion was easily bleeding on touch or when she just passed a washcloth over it. That is when she decided to have the lesion examined and biopsied.

The biopsy revealed a "basal cell carcinoma" and her doctor suggested "Mohs micrographic Surgery." (This is a method by which layer upon layer of a suspicious lesion is removed, until the entire tumor tissue is gone.) When this procedure was explained to Lori, she refused the surgery

Gerson Basics Workshop—A Huge Success!

"As a Hospice RN in San Jose, I see lots of patients dying from cancer. One client told me he survived stage 3 cancer 11 years ago using the Gerson Therapy. I told a friend with prostate cancer about this. After one month of juicing he did not need radiation." Lucy Liu's story is just one of 48 people (with 20 more on the waiting list!) who attended the February Gerson Basics Workshop.

The Workshop is designed to provide a basic yet thorough overview of how to get started on the Gerson Therapy. Sessions included: overview and history by Charlotte Gerson; how to do a coffee enema; juicing and cooking demonstrations; preparing clay and castor oil packs; an explanation of the

Gerson supplements and medications; how to set up the home; dental health; caring for patients and coping with healing reactions.

People with cancer, thyroid disease, fibromyalgia and other challenges came to the

Workshop to learn how

to get started on the Therapy. They benefitted from presentations by two recovered melanoma patients, Howie Doan and Lisa Mendoza. Others wanted to learn to protect their families. A young mother from Colorado wants to bring up her three children in a better world and get them to eat natural foods. Several had a family history of cancer, wanted to prevent illness or wished they had known about the Gerson Therapy when their relatives got sick. People attended who had just recently discovered the Gerson Therapy from watching The Beautiful Truth on Netflix. Longtime friends also attended, including David Gilbert, a monthly donor whose company Schneider Electric matches his monthly donations. He had read the book Does Max Gerson Really Have a Cure for Cancer back in 1970.

Allison Pulsipher, a Tennessee Oncology Nurse, realized chemotherapy makes people sick and kills them. She always thought that nutrition was the answer. She started a modified version of the Therapy because "if you want people to listen to you, you have to do it yourself. It is amazing what happens to you." After six weeks, her depression lifted, she never felt so calm in her life, her fear of crowds disappeared and her anger passed on. She wants to offer an alternative to people in her area.

Lucy Knoessl from Canada has been on a modified version of the Therapy for two years and has had no colds or flu. She started *The Gerson Project—Impossible is Temporary and Incurable is an Opinion* to tell everyone about the Therapy, including showing Gerson videos in her home. Jose Rosas,

"What your doctor won't tell you is that a mammogram exposes you to approximately 1,000 times the amount of radiation you'd get in a chest X-ray. If that's not enough, the radiation is stored in your cells and so it accumulates to significant levels over time if you're getting an annual mammogram.

"What your doctor won't tell you is that the extreme compression of your breast tissues in a mammography machine can damage delicate breast tissue and may even break open cancerous tumors and send them throughout your breast where they will

Patient's granddaughter says: "Dr. Gerson Cured My Grandfather of TB"

Hello, Charlotte Gerson,

My name is Rosemarie Teichert, and I think your father cured my grandfather, Karl Koenker, of lung tuberculosis in the 1920s.

I never knew my grandfather, but my mother told me that a Dr. Gerson cured him of TB!

He was on a diet of oranges and lemon juices. The healing process went so fast, that he had to eat the whole fruit.

My mother always said Dr. Gerson gave him ten more years to live! He finally died in 1938, the year I was born.

Dr. Gerson used my grandfather as a [demonstration] model in his lectures!

My Grandfather lived in the City of Buende, in the State of Westfalia, in Germany.

The doctor further points out that it is easy to obtain a false positive, putting the woman through tremendous stress, further testing, and often surgeries or other treatments that are unnecessary and damaging. He goes on to say that many reports and medical articles show that monthly selfexamination of the breast are perfectly able to obtain the same or better information about possible problems or no problem at

all than mammograms.

Dr. Johnson writes: "We think mammograms are highly detrimental to your body, mind and spirit. We recommend that you avoid them as a screening tool.

"Fortunately, there is a safe and effective alternative to mammography: Thermography is absolutely the best preventive tool because it can pick up a potential problem long before a mammogram might."

Of course we also feel strongly that an organic vegetarian, salt-free diet of fresh fruit, vegetables, salads and juices is an active preventive approach, second to none.

... and The Medical Damage of HRT (Hormone Replacement Therapy)

For the women who have survived the "annual mammograms" suggested by the medical system, there are new dangers. Those are the cancer-causing effects of Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT).

For thousands of years women went through menopause with minimal problems, or, at least, with problems that were untreated and abated with time (and without cancer!). Not any more. Big Pharma discovered that menopause is another rich source for pharmaceutical income. In 1942, Premarin[®] came on the market. As the name indicates, it is made from PREgnant MAres' uRINe. Premarin, according to Dr. Ben Johnson (The Secret of Health-Breast Wisdom, by Ben Johnson, MD, DO, NMD and Kathleen Barnes, Morgan James Publishing, Garden City, NY) contains some 23 complex hormones that are not found (and don't belong) in humans. Yet doctors (listening to the pharmaceutical producers) have since touted it as "the best thing that ever happened to menopausal women." It is supposed to protect women from heart disease, strokes, osteoporosis and even breast cancer. Dr. Johnson quotes many articles proving that the contrary is true. He writes, "Instead women who took the drug were found to have a dramatically increased risk of serious and potentially fatal diseases ...

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and 27 percent more heart attacks than those who got the placebo, along with 26 percent higher risk of breast cancer." (p. 73) "Then a new combination hormone came on the market which promised to overcome the imbalances created by Premarin, namely Prempro[®]. This drug also contained progesterone which, women are told, makes it 'safe'. Not so!"

A year after it came on the market, "... researchers found that women taking Prempro had twice the risk of dementia (Alzheimer's) and a variety of other diseases of mental deterioration."

At this point Dr. Johnson recommends "Bioidentical hormone replacement." He says, "These are natural ways to safely duplicate these hormones exactly as your body manufactured them in its prime." They are prescription items, regulated by the FDA and "found to be safe." There are also some herbal products available, such as Black Cohosh and others that seem to work. The Gerson Therapy has been shown to reduce problems of menopause, including night sweats, depression, hot flushes, etc., to the point where the adrenals have taken over the reduced activity of the female hormones and women feel well, have smooth skin, and safely reverse osteoporosis!

From a Web article The Cancer Risk From CT Scans

CT (Computed X-ray Tomography) Scans deliver far more radiation than has generally been believed, and may contribute to 29,000 new cancers each year, as well as 14,500 deaths," says Joseph J. Mercola, M.D. in a Web article Dec. 29, 2009.

According to the latest measurements, a patient could get as much radiation from one CT scan as 74 mammograms or 442 chest X-rays. Of women in their early 20s who get one coronary angiogram and a CT scan of the heart, 150 will develop cancer related to the procedure.

Dr. Mercola further warns, "If your child undergoes a CT scan, chances are that the equipment is calibrated to an adult. This means that the child could absorb two to six times more radiation than needed to produce a clear image and could result in radiation-induced cancer later in life. However, adults are not safe. Over 200 unsuspecting patients who underwent a specific type of CT brain scan at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles received eight to 10 times the normal dose of radiation due to an incorrectly programmed machine!

The overdose was only "accidentally" discovered after 18 months when one patient reported losing patches of hair following a CT scan.

Mammograms are another example of overused, risky imaging. They expose the body to radiation that can be 1,000 times greater than that from a chest x-ray. Mammography compresses the breasts tightly, which is not only painful, but it can spread cancer cells if they exist.

A study by the University of California, San Francisco, has revealed that the number of CT scans doubled between 1997 and 2006. Still worse, the prestigious medical journal, *The New England Journal of Medicine* stated that in 1980 three million CT scans were performed in the U.S. By 2006, the number had exceeded 62 million, including four million on children.

Dr. Mercola feels that one reason for the increase is that many doctors have purchased their own imaging equipment. This adds a financial incentive to the problem and sets the stage for overuse. Furthermore, they want to "find out everything wrong with *you:* that enables them to use still more drugs and procedures and charge more money." Patients are told that it is a "preventive" measure. David Brenner of Columbia University, lead author of the study, estimates that a third of all CT scans are medically unnecessary. This researcher told USA Today that "Virtually anyone who presents in the emergency room with pain in the belly or a chronic headache will automatically get a CT scan." Still worse, many CT scans are performed by commercial enterprises and the quality of the tests is so poor as to render the results virtually useless.

There is a 100% safe imaging technology: Thermography. It is safe, non-invasive and simple. It measures the infrared heat from the body and translates the information into anatomical images. There is no compression of breasts, and no radiation. It also can detect signs of breast cancer up to 10 years before a mammogram or a physical exam.

Planning ahead Annual Apple Alert!

The usual fresh crop of apples arrives on the market during the middle of August (in the Northern hemisphere). By June, the old crop of organic apples is gone and already in late May, only organic 'red delicious' apples are available. Those are too sweet for regular juicing; they may even cause the juice to jell!

It is therefore important to plan ahead for this time: go to your health food store or regular supplier of organic produce and pay in advance for two or three boxes of green apples (greenings, granny smith, or others, except red or golden delicious) and ask him to store it in his refrigerated warehouse for you. You can then pick them up as you need them.

Also when the first new crop comes in, it is often somewhat unripe, and sour. At such a time, we suggest that you mix those apples with some of the old (even sweet) apples in order to avoid stomach upsets.

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Multiple myeloma, multiple sclerosis, Hashimoto's thyroiditis ... An Unusually Exciting Day in Mexico

I have been asked how I can stand to visit with "terminal patients" every week. Would that not be so depressing, more every week?

My answer has always been, "On the contrary!" It is exciting and wonderful to see the regular progress toward healing these patients make. They feel better every week, look better, and visualize living a normal, active life again—when previously they had been told that they had no more than a few months of life left.

But yesterday (March 3) was even better than usual! For one, we had an unusual assortment of different diagnoses—while most of the time, we see mainly terminal cancer patients.

My first visit was with David. He had come in with a far advanced case of multiple myeloma. His bones were seriously damaged; he was bent and the previous physicians had put a hardening material into his vertebrae so he would not break them! His breast bone was so weak, it had bulged out in a rounded protrusion, and he was wearing a wired brace around his chest to hold him up!

All his bones were affected, his arms and legs were severely painful, and he could barely walk a few feet to the bathroom. He had received chemo, which didn't help. He had poor circulation to his fingers and toes and was on constant pain medication when he arrived in Mexico. He had trouble sleeping and eating but fortunately he was able to drink the juices.

Just one week after I first saw him, he was virtually free of pain, and off pain medication. He was able to go to the bathroom and even walk a short distance! His circulation was largely restored; the neuropathy in his fingers and toes had almost completely disappeared. And far from visualizing his family's (wife and kids) survival without him, he was planning what to do when he recovered! He was eating nice large plates filled with organic salad and vegetables; and had started to gain weight.

The next room held a patient suffering from melanoma. He had surgery on the first tumor, on his right shin, and this lesion had barely healed, when there was already another lump growing, only about one inch above. That, too, was removed, however there were more lumps, including one in his groin. (In other words, the melanoma had spread to his lymphatic system, making it "terminal".) The latest surgery had left a number of metal clips which were installed by the original doctor to help the edges of his skin to heal. Fortunately he had not received chemotherapy.

When I saw him just one week later, that great day in Mexico, the clips had been removed; the skin had healed, the lump in his groin had disappeared, the previous scars were soft and returning to a normal skin color—he had a great appetite and asked if he could be served more juices! Of course! 13 is a minimum, actually there is no maximum! The doctor ordered at least six to ten additional juices! He was also eating large portions, and asking for more. So the doctor also ordered an extra plate of oatmeal after the evening meal, before retiring! This patient, too, is making a wonderful recovery!

Then there was George. He was suffering from multiple sclerosis. His diagnosis (by his U.S. doctors) was made with an MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) machine, and his lesions were interestingly in his brain. (The usual multiple sclerosis lesions occur in the myelin sheaths that line the nerves in the spine, legs and arms.) He had lost much of his balance, had little control of his feet, was unable to place one foot in front of the other. In just one week, he had regained most of his sense of balance, was able to place his feet one ahead of the other; felt very well and could see his approaching recovery!

And Sasha, too, came in with an unusual diagnosis: Hashimoto's thyroiditis, a supposedly auto-immune disease. It is described as an inflammation that eventually destroys the thyroid gland. It is also supposedly more common in people who have a history of auto-immune diseases. Sasha is 42, and while of European ancestry, she lives with her family in mainland China. Prior to coming for the Gerson Therapy, Sasha was having serious trouble breathing and complained to her local doctors of not being able to get enough breath. The doctors checked her test results and were unable to pin down any specific reason for that problem. So they told her that it was all in her head, that there was nothing wrong with her. Still, she was unable to breathe normally.

When she was tested at the Mexican clinic, she had a very low pH (she was quite acidic). The Gerson Therapy resolves that problem in very short order; most acidity is caused by eating animal proteins. The vegetarian, organic Gerson food and juices are able to reverse this situation rapidly. Usually in just one week, the body's pH is up in a normal range, just above 7.0 (which is neutral) and the blood is again able to carry oxygen.

When Sasha heard my lecture about the difficulty of blood carrying oxygen when it is in an acid condition (per Otto Warburg) she was greatly relieved and understood her problem. It was clearly not "in her mind," but in the acidity of her blood. Unfortunately, when doctors don't understand the reason for an ailment, they generally blame the patient! This is a very serious, mean and damaging method of dealing with a problem. Then they often go further and state that the problem is caused by stressare they not the ones now *causing* the stress? But Sasha is now happy, has no problem breathing and is able to carry on normally, with adequate oxygen in her system. With the improvement in her thyroid condition, her immune system restored, as well, she will be able to live normally. She may need to continue thyroid medication for some time in the future, which the Gerson doctor will be able to determine.

Joseph Biederman's Comeuppance

Biederman is undone.

And that's truly great news.

Is it too extreme to call this guy a monster? I'll let you decide.

Here's a quick recap ...

From the late '90s to about 2007, Harvard child psychiatrist Dr. Joseph Biederman conducted research that aggressively broadened the definition of bipolar disorder. According to PBS' Frontline, there was a 4,000 percent increase in the number of children diagnosed as bipolar over the decade that Biederman and colleagues expanded the concept of the disorder.

Four THOUSAND percent.

And that research prompted a huge jump in the use of powerful (and potentially dangerous) antipsychotic medications for very young children.

A new study, published just last month, found that antipsychotic drugs prescribed for children between the ages of 2 to 5 doubled over the past decade. For that we can thank Biederman and his influential claim that mood swings in children as young as 2 can be diagnosed as bipolar.

Revolting, no? And all of that would be bad enough. But it gets much worse.

Two years ago, Senator Charles Grassley accused Biederman of failing to fully disclose payments from drug companies that make antipsychotic drugs.

According to the *New York Times*, Biederman accepted more than \$1.6 million from drug companies between 2000 and 2007.

But, yeah, it gets even worse.

Court documents revealed that Biederman assured Johnson & Johnson executives that studies he was involved in would end up showing benefits of two different antipsychotic drugs made by J&J. At the time, Biederman was director of the Johnson & Johnson Center for Pediatric Psychopathology Research at Massachusetts General Hospital.

Bottom line: Biederman fattened his bank account nicely while his influence prompted unnecessary drug use in untold number of infants.

Sweet comeuppance

There was a time when Biederman's influence seemed unstoppable.

In 2007, Dr. Lawrence Diller told the Boston Globe that colleagues in the child psychiatry field were afraid to speak out against Biederman.

Dr. Diller: "To politely challenge Biederman in public is to risk public retribution and ridicule from him and his team. Also academic researchers in child psychiatry risk losing their funding if they criticize this darling of the pharmaceutical industry ..."

So it's with the greatest pleasure that I share this with you today: Biederman is about to be undone.

The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders is psychiatry's combination guidebook and encyclopedia. And it's now being revised for a new edition.

According to the *New York Times*, this manual draws the line between normal and not normal, and provides psychiatrists with their primary guide for treating patients.

A Columbia University psychiatry professor told the *Times*, "Anything you put in that book, any little change you make, has huge implications not only for psychiatry but for pharmaceutical marketing."

The new edition is not yet completed, but the *Times* reports that the definition of bipolar disorder in children will be significantly changed. And that change will sharply reduce the use of antipsychotic medications for the very young.

According to one psychiatrist: "The treatment of bipolar disorder is meds first, meds second and meds third." But if children are diagnosed instead with a behavior disorder, then the primary treatment is behavioral treatment before drugs are considered.

It's a sad day for Johnson & Johnson and other companies that make antipsychotic drugs. And it's a sad day for Biederman and his undone influence.

But it's an excellent day for the kids.

More vaccine fraud emerges Danish Researcher Disappears with \$2 Million

The Danish media reported on March 5, 2010 that ten million Danish kroner (the equivalent of just under two million dollars) is missing from the Aarhus University, along with the lead researcher of the Denmark Autism studies on which the CDC based their opinion that vaccines preserved with the highly poisonous mercury compound Thimerosal is "safe" and have no connection with autism. The article goes on to ask, "What moron actually believes that giving children a neurotoxin at 25,000 times the concentration allowed in drinking water will *protect* the child from brain injury?"

They only ship outside of the United States. On the web site is a list of countries that they cannot ship to without a prescription. They can only send one bottle of thyroid per customer per order but can send up to five bottles of the Naturethroid.
